Pick

Promptly pick your ripe fruit and vegetables. Prune fruit trees so you can pick more easily next season.



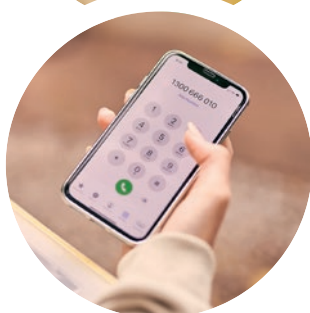
Collect

Collect fallen fruit. Put it in your green bin, or in a sealed plastic bag and into general waste.



Check

Check your fruit for blemishes and maggots.
